

ELECTIVE COURSE OPTIONS

Given the highly interdisciplinary nature of sustainability, students take a number of different electives offered across Hofstra. There are no formal requirements for electives besides confirming with the Sustainability Director that it is appropriate for your degree program. There are several graduate level (i.e. level 600) courses to choose from, however, graduate students are also allowed to take up to two undergraduate courses- (equivalently 100 graduate credit, as long as the instructor permits. You should also check with the Sustainability Director to confirm an undergraduate class is appropriate for your program. Below is a non-exhaustive list of popular courses taken as electives by sustainability graduate students. Please note that not all classes are offered every semester.
