Preventing the Spread of COVID-19

Rider to the agreement dated _____ (“Agreement”) between Hofstra University (“University”) and _____ (along with all of Contractor’s employees, agents, subcontractors, guests and invitees, hereinafter collectively referred to as “Contractor(s)”).

All University contractors, vendors, and visitors to the Hofstra campus are required to comply with all applicable health and safety rules to prevent the spread of COVID-19. This includes all federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations, and orders, including New York State’s COVID-19-related Executive Orders, Reopening Guidance, Statewide Guidelines and industry/function-specific Guidelines (“Laws”), and well as applicable Hofstra University policies (“Policies”), which are posted on <https://www.hofstra.edu/safe-start/> or are otherwise provided, and which may be updated from time to time. Contractors entering the Hofstra campus must maintain a social distance of 6 feet from others, must cover nose and mouth with a mask, and must not enter the campus if they are experiencing or have come in contact with anyone experiencing any of the “Symptoms of Coronavirus” set forth by the CDC. Contractor acknowledges that it is Contractor’s responsibility to be aware of and comply with all such Laws and Policies, and to ensure that all of Contractor’s employees, agents, personnel, subcontractors,
