We had someone come into the Hillel office just today with concerns about the Jewish High holidays that will be observed and professors are planning exams/labs but these professors are not allowing excused absences for this.
 - a. Cornell Craig: I don't want anyone to think that just because we have not commented, it does not mean that we do not care about this incident. We do look into complaints but with this current one, as it is anonymous, it is hard to pin down this and rectify the issue. We did send out an email in the beginning of the semester about sensitivity towards religious observances that will be occurring throughout the entire year. I encourage the student, or any student to report this as it can be a learning opportunity for not only the staff but also the student. We have been working off a secular calendar for the past 4 years which we drill home to the faculty to look at the calendar
 - i. Senator Siegel: Do you think we could do training about the religious holidays that will occur and how to handle it?
 1. Cornell Craig: My office did make this calendar to give the professor a resource and we are trying to make it not only easy but to guide them in this. It can be harder when the accommodations also may make it difficult for the student (ie. taking a test 2 days earlier versus on the high holiday). We all have blind spots.

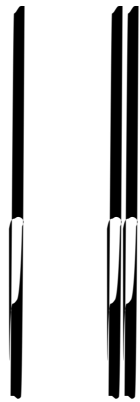
